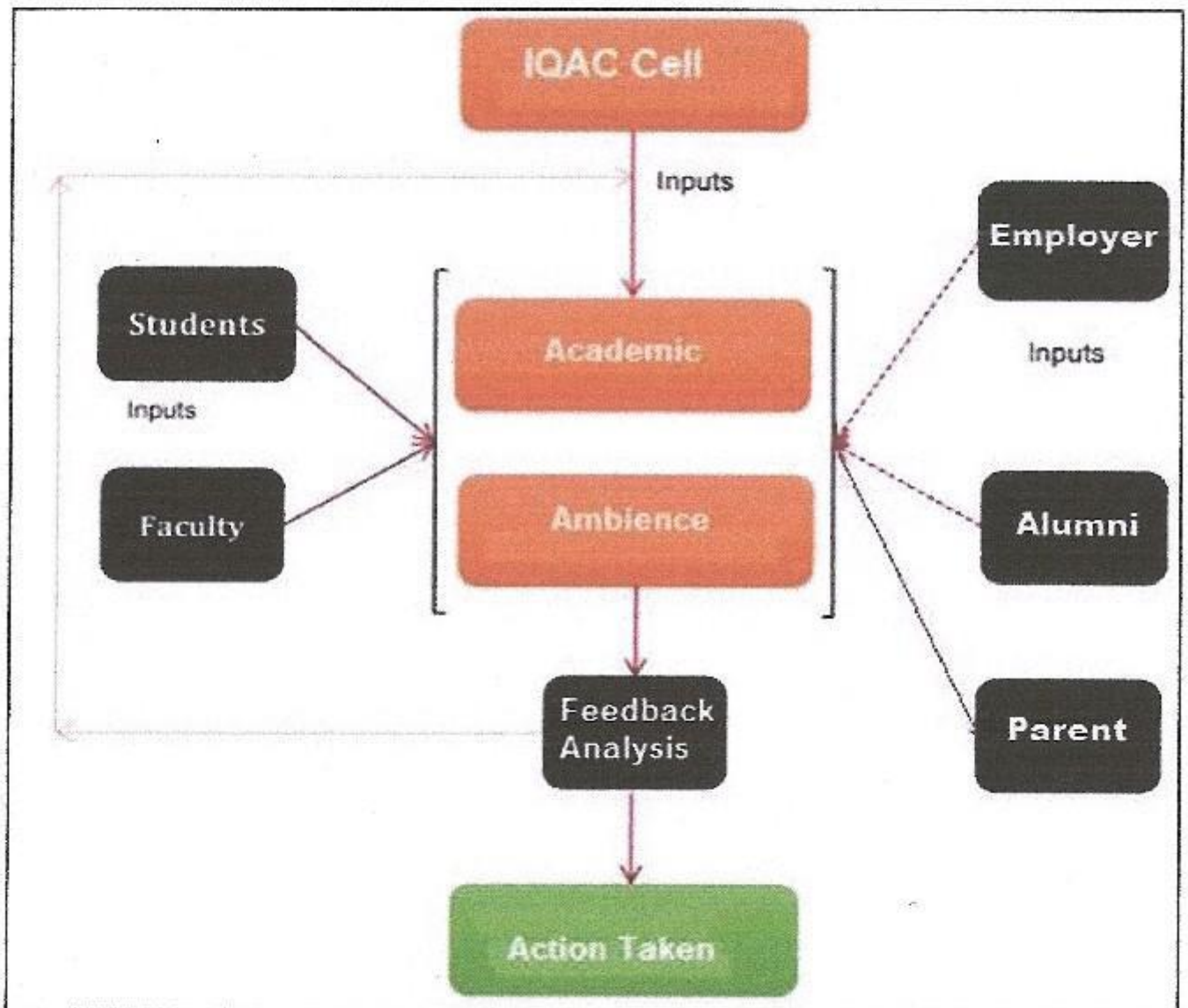

- The feedback collected from the students has been analyzed and action taken to strengthen the quality of teaching learning environment and to look for opportunities to improve overall performances including teacher in classroom engagement with students to bring excellence in teaching and learning.
- This questionnaire is intended to collect information relating to your satisfaction towards facilities and services provided for creating conducive atmosphere for teaching and learning.
- The information provided by the students was kept confidential and was used as important feedback for quality improvement of the various courses and programs offered by Jaihind College of Engineering Kuran.
- In order to arrive at comprehensive results, statistical analysis and graphic representations has been undertaken.
- The responses are scored in a five-point scale for each item i.e., Excellent, Very Good, Good, Average and Poor. Student indicates his / her level of agreement with the following statements by selecting appropriate option.
- Total consolidated responses received were 472 from FE, SE, TE, BE Students. The department has analyzed the responses of student's feedback form and report submitted to authorities, and appropriate action has to be taken place.
- As per Guidelines from IQAC Department if student's response is equal to or less than 40 % in particular questionnaires corrective analysis has to be done and suggestion has to be sent to concern authority for corrective action.

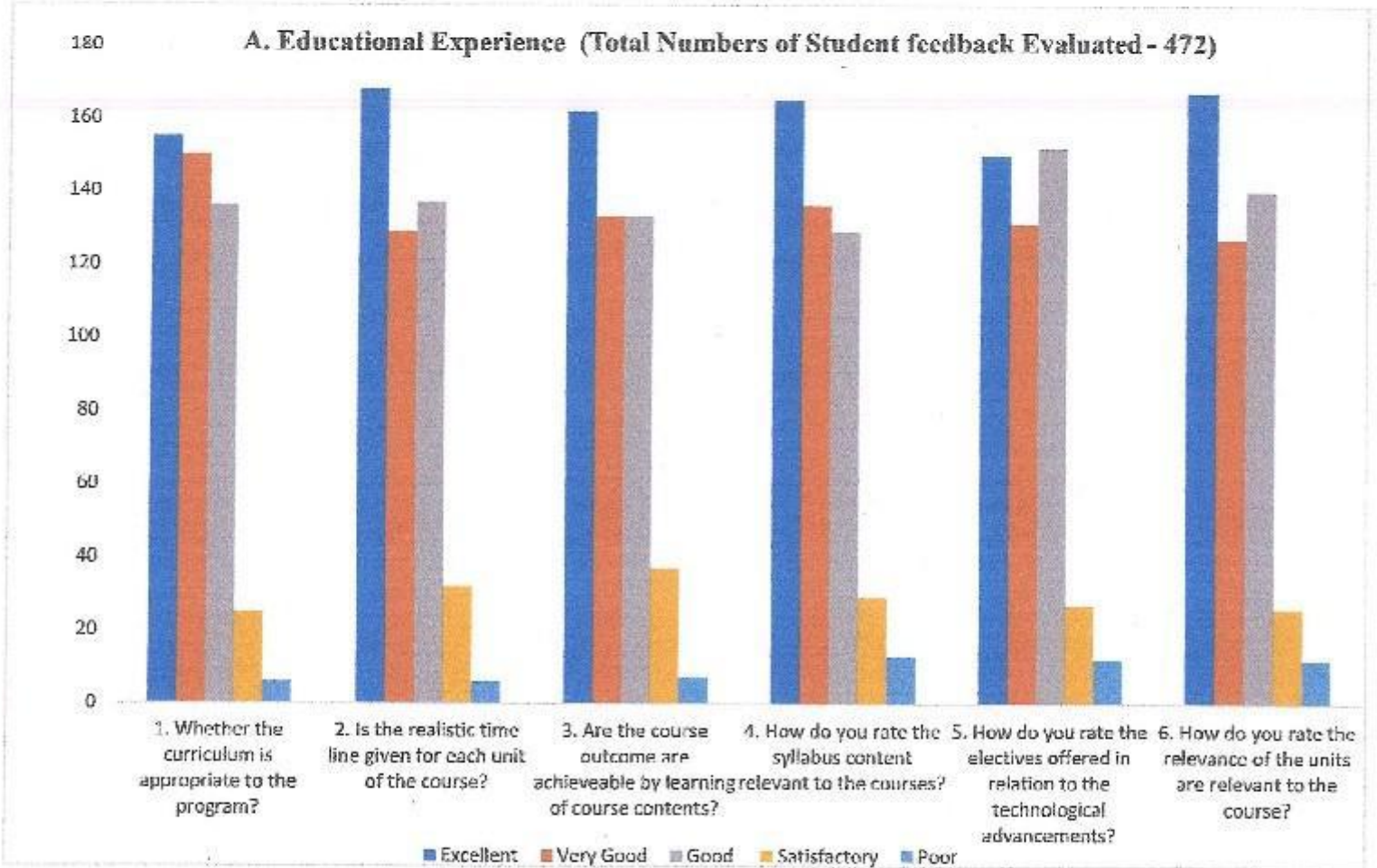

Graphical Representation of Feedback Analysis:



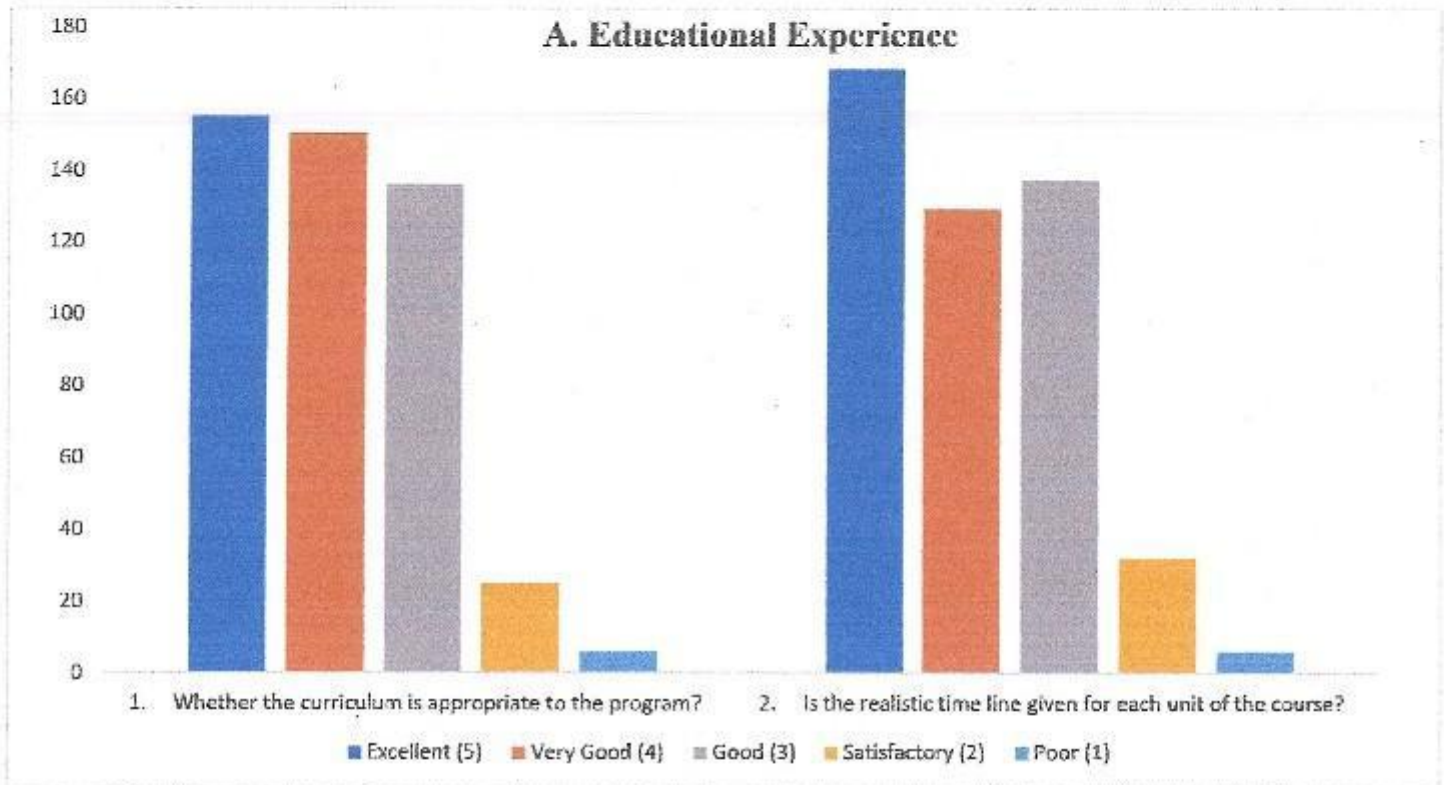
Feedback Points

Observation: - The overall educational experience is perceived positively by the majority of students, with most areas receiving over 90% approval in the combined Excellent and Good categories. While the educational experience is generally rated highly, there is room for improvement, particularly in ensuring that the course units' timeline and syllabus content better align with student expectations.

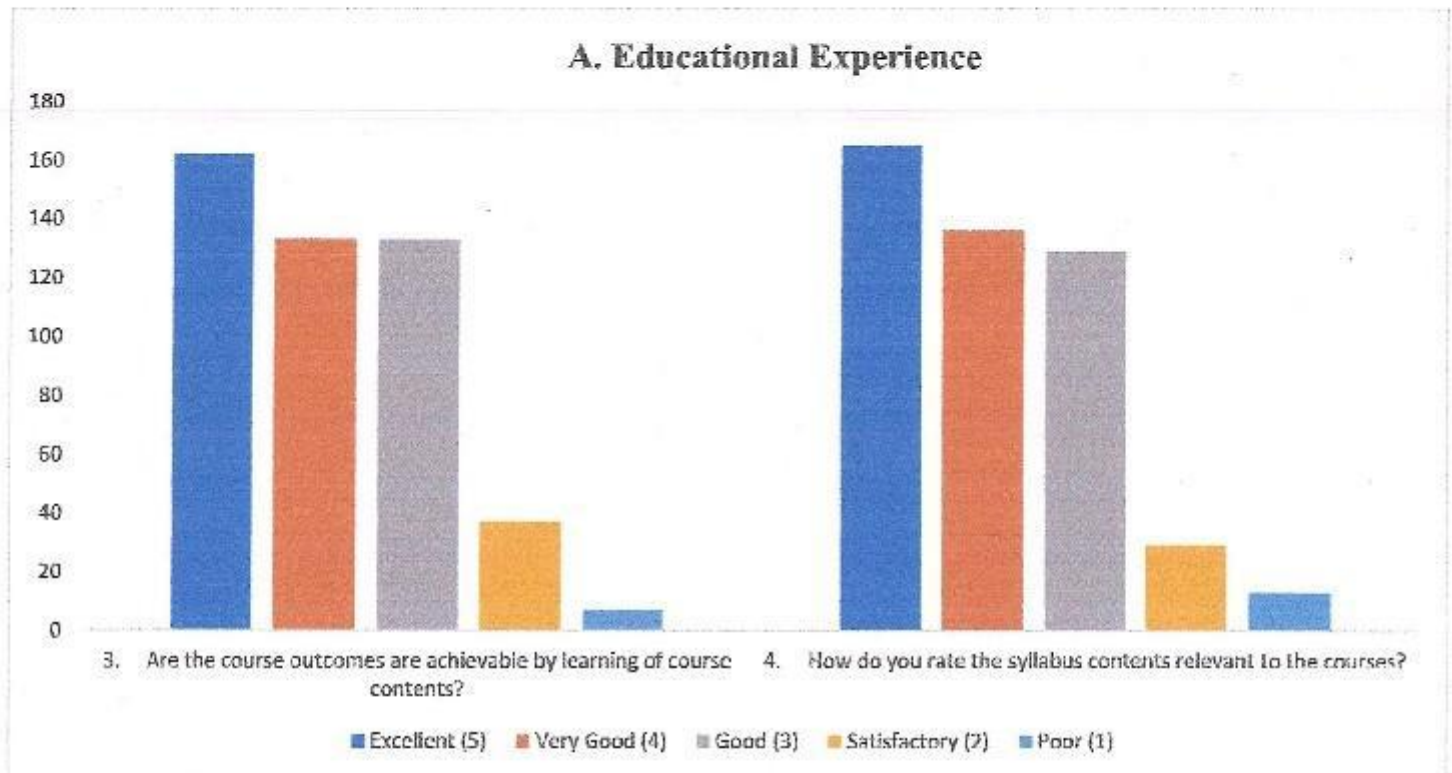
Observation: -

1. **93.42%** of students gave Excellent and Good responses, indicating that the curriculum is appropriately aligned with the program.
2. **91.95%** of students gave Excellent and Good responses, agreeing that the timeline provided for each course unit is realistic.

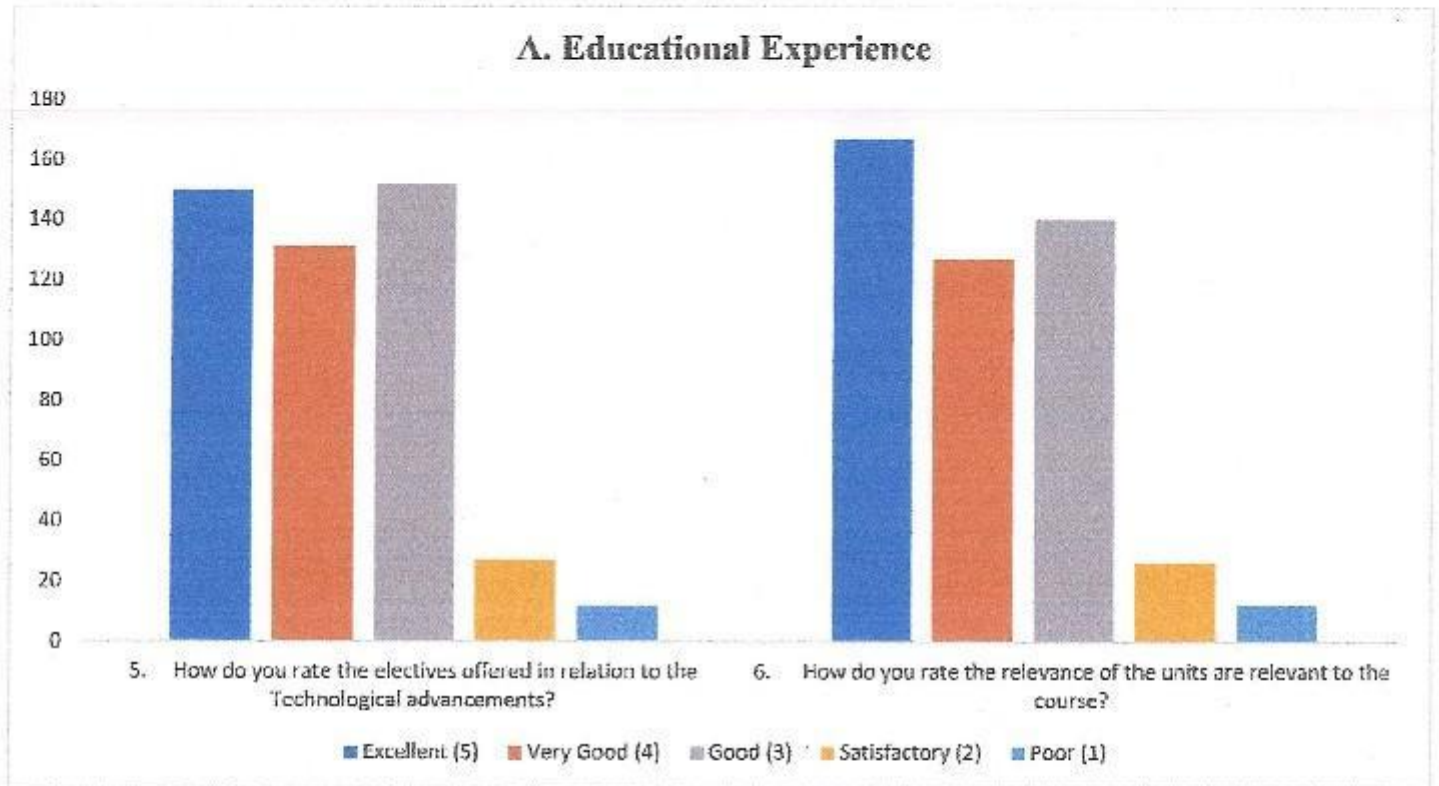
Observation: -

Students Feedback Analysis Academic Performance and Ambience A.Y.2023-24

The following points emerged from the analysis of students' feedback survey:

1. **93.42%** of the students are highly satisfied with the appropriateness of the curriculum to the program.
2. **91.95%** of the students are happy with the realistic timeline given for each unit of the course.
3. **90.68%** of the students are satisfied with the achievement of course outcomes through the learning of course content.
4. **91.10%** of the students are happy with the relevance of the syllabus content to the courses.
5. **91.74%** of the students are satisfied with the electives offered in relation to technological advancements.
6. **91.95%** of the students are happy with the relevance of the units to the course.

Students' Suggestions/Observations:

1. **63.35%** of students are happy with the overall course structure and content but suggested improvements in the timeline and syllabus content to better align with student expectations.
2. **36.65%** of students expressed dissatisfaction with certain aspects of the educational experience, indicating areas for improvement in course alignment with technological advancements and relevance.

This analysis highlights that while the majority of students are satisfied with the educational experience, there are still areas that could benefit from further refinement, particularly in aligning course content and timelines with student expectations.
