## REPORT

### DAY – 1: INDUCTION PROGRAM: AARAMBHA 2024

#### CHIEF GUEST: DR. RAJENDRASING KISANSING PARDESHI

Friday, 4 October 2024

The Educational institutions play an important role in development of individual, family and society, laying foundation of a strong nation. The goal is to enrich all fields of knowledge, inculcate sense of responsibility and enhance the inner potential of an individual. When new students enter an institution, they come with diverse thoughts, backgrounds and preparations. They come into a new unfamiliar environment and many of them have little knowledge of a university / college. An important task, therefore, is to welcome new students to Higher Education and prepare them for their new role. Student Induction Programme engages with the new students as soon as they come into the institution. At the start of the induction, the incumbents learn about the institutional policies, processes, practices, culture and values.

JCEI's Jaihind Institute of Management and Research organized an "Induction Program-AARAMBHA 2024" for the batch 2024-26" for two days on Friday, 4<sup>th</sup> October and Saturday, 5<sup>th</sup> October 2024. The days were fully packed with the learning activities and fun games.

The program on day one was inaugurated with the Saraswati Poojan at the hands of the chief guest Dr. Rajendrasing Kisansing Pardeshi in presence of Mr. Pamod Bhadakwade (Ex. Dy. Registrar Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune), Mr. Jitendra Gunjal (Chairman JCEI), Dr. Shubhangi Gunjal (Director JCEI) and Dr. D.S.
